

# Frame Size Calculator Worksheet

**Width                      and                      Height**

## A) Measure Artwork's Original Size

Measure your artwork from edge to edge.

<b>12</b>	<b>3/4</b>

## B) Determine Desired Mat Offset

- This is only required if your print goes to the edge of the paper and you are using mats.
- Usually either 1/8" or 1/4" on each side is used as an offset.

## B) Framed Artwork Size

- Subtract the total mat offset (B) from the artwork's original size (A).
- This is the size of your framed artwork. You will enter this information into the website when asked for your artwork's size.
